

**NOTICE OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to the registered qualified voters of Lone Jack Consolidated School District No. 6 of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Board of Education of said School District has called a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020. *In accordance with Missouri Governor Michael L. Parson's Executive Order 20-03 dated March 13, 2020, the April 7, 2020 General Municipal Election was officially rescheduled to June 2, 2020.* The polls will be open from 6 a.m. until 7 p.m.

The Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners will conduct the election in that part of the District within Jackson County; the Clerk of the Cass County Commission will conduct the election in that part of the District within Cass County; and the Clerk of the Johnson County Commission will conduct the election in that part of the District within Johnson County.

**QUESTION**

Shall the Board of Education of the Lone Jack C-6 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the betterment of school facilities including, without limitation: the construction, equipping, and furnishing of additional classrooms that will also contain space as a storm shelter at the elementary school; to prepay the existing track lease financing; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.8747 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

**NOTICE OF ACCESSIBILITY**

**FURTHER NOTICE IS GIVEN that, where a regular polling place has limited accessibility, a disabled or elderly voter may be provided an alternative means of casting his or her ballot. Such means may include reassignment to an accessible polling place, curbside voting, assisted voting or voting by absentee ballot. A voter may apply for an absentee ballot in person or by mail, or may have a relative or guardian apply in person on his or her behalf. If an absentee voter is disabled or incapacitated, the notary requirement is waived. In addition, voters requiring assistance may be assisted by a person of the voter's choice.**
