

**NOTICE OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
THE JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT  
OF METROPOLITAN KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI  
TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 2020**

Notice is hereby given to the registered qualified voters of Subdistrict Number 5 of the Junior College District of Metropolitan Kansas City, Missouri, that the Board of Trustees of said Junior College District has called a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 to elect one Trustee for a term of six years in Subdistrict Number 5. *In accordance with Missouri Governor Michael L. Parson's Executive Order 20-03 dated March 13, 2020, the April 7, 2020 General Municipal Election was officially rescheduled to June 2, 2020.* The polls will be open from 6 a.m. until 7 p.m.

The Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners will conduct the election in that part of Subdistrict 5 of the Junior College District within Jackson County; the Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners will conduct the election in that part of Subdistrict 5 of the Junior College District within the Jackson County corporate limits of Kansas City.

**NOTICE OF ACCESSIBILITY**

**FURTHER NOTICE IS GIVEN that, where a regular polling place has limited accessibility, a disabled or elderly voter may be provided an alternative means of casting his or her ballot. Such means may include reassignment to an accessible polling place, curbside voting, assisted voting or voting by absentee ballot. A voter may apply for an absentee ballot in person or by mail, or may have a relative or guardian apply in person on his or her behalf. If an absentee voter is disabled or incapacitated, the notary requirement is waived. In addition, voters requiring assistance may be assisted by a person of the voter's choice.**
