Notice is hereby given to the registered qualified voters of Sni-Valley Fire Protection District of Jackson and Lafayette Counties, Missouri, that the Board of Directors of said Fire District has called a Special election to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020. *In accordance with Missouri Governor Michael L. Parson's Executive Order 20-03 dated March 13, 2020, the April 7, 2020 General Municipal Election was officially rescheduled to June 2, 2020.* The polls will be open from 6 a.m. until 7 p.m.

The Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners will conduct the election in that part of the District within Jackson County and the Clerk of the Lafayette County Commission will conduct the election in that part of the District within Lafayette County.

**NOTICE OF ACCESSIBILITY**

**FURTHER NOTICE IS GIVEN that, where a regular polling place has limited accessibility, a disabled or elderly voter may be provided an alternative means of casting his or her ballot. Such means may include reassignment to an accessible polling place, curbside voting, assisted voting or voting by absentee ballot. A voter may apply for an absentee ballot in person or by mail, or may have a relative or guardian apply in person on his or her behalf. If an absentee voter is disabled or incapacitated, the notary requirement is waived. In addition, voters requiring assistance may be assisted by a person of the voter's choice.**
